*\$140,287,175 in Federal stimulus funds through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) were provided to school districts through the TEEOSA program in FY 2010-11. This brings the total to \$950,235,644.

**\$115,000,000 was appropriated to the Property Tax Credit Act to reduce property taxes; however, due to the Homestead Exemption program, for which the state pays part or all of a qualified homeowner's property tax, some of the property tax credit monies provided to the counties is returned as unused.
