This 2011-2012 Report of State Aid to Local Subdivisions was prepared by the Nebraska Department of Revenue pursuant to [Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1704.01](#) for distribution to Nebraska taxpayers.

Section One contains a schedule for all 93 counties listing the local subdivisions receiving state aid. Each schedule includes the net amount of property taxes levied in 2011 for collection in 2012, and the amount of general fund aid from various state sources for FY 2011-12. Total property taxes levied are total property taxes including the homestead exemption. Additional amounts of FY 2011-12 allocations of state aid distributed to each county are listed separately. Additional State Aid for the State Temporary School Fund, the Homestead Exemption Distribution, the Property Tax Credit, and the Nebraska Resource Development Funds are not allocated by political subdivisions within each county. The total for each county receiving funds is listed separately on each county's schedule.

Section Two includes a tabulation of specific aid programs funded by the Legislature from state revenue sources, and a summary of state aid paid to local subdivisions in each county. Also included is a table of property taxes levied from 1978 to 2011.


