*\$1,097,838 in Federal stimulus funds through the Education Jobs Fund program were provided to school districts through the TEEOSA program in FY 2011-12. This brings the total to \$822,938,737.

**\$115,000,000 was appropriated to the Property Tax Credit Act to reduce property taxes; however, due to the Homestead Exemption program, for which the state pays part or all of a qualified homeowner's property tax, some of the property tax credit monies provided to the counties is returned unused.
