Instructions

Who Must File. Every county assessor must complete this certificate and forward it to the county treasurer. The county treasurer is then required to certify the total revenue that will be lost to all taxing agencies within the county due to the approved homestead exemption applications.

When and Where to File. This certificate must be filed on or before November 30, with the Nebraska Department of Revenue at pat.homestead@nebraska.gov.

Changes to Certificate. The certificate may be amended to show any change or correction in the total tax loss until May 30 of the next year, or when corrections are made by the Tax Commissioner. An Amended Homestead Exemption Summary Certificate, Form 458X, **must** be used if there is any change or correction to this report.

Combine All Classifications of Real Property on One Certificate. Combine and enter the total number of applications allowed a homestead exemption, the corresponding amount of assessed value exempted, and the resulting tax loss.

Authorized Signatures. This certificate must be signed by the county assessor and the county treasurer.
