Attention Cash Device Community:

The vast majority of Cash Devices and locations have been successfully connected to the central monitoring system and nearly all manufacturers' device software has received approval from the testing laboratory.

To account for the many moving elements in equipment placement, software testing and connection establishment, the July 1 system go live date was deferred to July 15 and licensees were given until July 31 to complete connection to the system.

The tax on Cash Device Net Operating Revenue went into effect July 1 as required by statute, and all cash devices in operation from that date forward have been subject to the tax. That means operators and distributors must account for sales activity and tax liability for any device operating since July 1, regardless of when the device was connected to the central system.

The payment of the Net Operating Revenue tax will be due quarterly, and the tax liability dates to July 1, 2025. Information on the filing process will be forthcoming from the Division, with information on your liability available from your central system reports.

This letter should be considered the FINAL NOTICE of the tax liability and the connectivity requirement to comply with the Cash Device Act. This notice should also be considered notice of future enforcement action. Any devices that were not successfully connected to the central system by July 31, 2025 must cease operations until such time as they are connected to the central system. All operators and distributors not in compliance with this notice will face enforcement action.

Please continue your interaction with Intralot regarding any connectivity work yet to be completed and contact the Division with questions or plans to add devices and locations.
