

Refund Rate Tables

The following rates should be used when claiming a refund of fuel tax paid on fuel used by an exempt entity or for a qualified nontaxable use. The refund is claimed on a [Nebraska Non-Ag Use Motor Fuels Tax Refund Claim, Form 84](#), or a [Nebraska Ag Use Motor Fuels Tax Refund Claim, Form 84AG](#).

Refund rate for Petroleum Release Remedial Action Fee:

- Gasoline, Gasohol, Aviation Gasoline and Ethanol is .009.
- Diesel and Jet Fuel is .003 through 09/30/2026.
- Effective 10/01/26, the undyed diesel and jet fuel fee is .006. Dyed diesel is no longer subject to the fee.

Refund rate for Aircraft Fuels:

- Aviation Gasoline is .05
- Jet Fuel is .03
