

Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act Board

Notice is hereby given of a public hearing of the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act (SAFFAA) Board, to be held November 20, 2025, in Room 1023, State Capitol, Lincoln, NE. The hearing is to receive documentary evidence and testimony regarding an application submitted by the City of Gretna, Nebraska and Wolf Pack Sports Foundation for financial assistance under SAFFAA, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-3101 through 13-3110 and is scheduled as the third agenda item. The City of Gretna and Wolf Pack Sports Foundation are seeking financial assistance to aid in the construction of two indoor, privately owned sports complexes with total estimated construction costs of \$28.46 million. The facilities will be equipped with 6 spring floors, 2 dead floors, 5 basketball courts convertible to volleyball courts, a tumbling tunnel, dance space, training space, meeting and office space, pre-function space, concessions, restrooms, and paved and lighted parking. The project is located near 202nd Street and NE Hwy 370 in Gretna, NE. The SAFFAA board meeting begins at 9:00 am. Hearings scheduled for this meeting will be held in accordance with the meeting agenda, which can be found on the Nebraska Department of Revenue (DOR) website, revenue.nebraska.gov.
