Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates -Effective April 1, 2019

MARCH 1, 2019 (LINCOLN, NEB.) - Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced the following changes in local sales and use tax rates for the upcoming quarter starting on **April 1, 2019**.

Ansley, DeWitt, Laurel, and **Pleasanton** will each start a local sales and use tax at the rate of 1%, and **Hubbard** will start a local sales and use tax at the rate of 1.5%.

Dakota City will increase its local sales and use tax rate to 1%.

Clay Center, Harrison, Oakland, Osmond, and Pender all will increase their local sales and use tax rate to 1.5%.

Beatrice, Fullerton, Grand Island, Loup City, Ord, Paxton, and **Sargent** all will increase their local sales and use tax rate to 2%
