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## Motor Fuels Tax Rate Set for July 1 through December 31, 2026

June 23, 2026 (LINCOLN, NEB.) – The Nebraska motor fuels tax rate for July 1 through December 31, 2026, will be 31.8 cents per gallon, unchanged from the current tax per gallon. The components of the future and current rates include wholesale, variable, and fixed rates.

The motor fuel tax rate setting process is established in Nebraska state law. Under Neb. Rev. Stat. § [66-489.02](#), the wholesale tax rate is calculated on the wholesale price of fuel. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ [66-4,140](#), [66-4,141](#), and [66-4,144](#), the variable rate is set to generate highway revenues consistent with legislative appropriations. For state fiscal year 2027, the legislatively approved Highway Cash Fund appropriation was established by LB 261, as enacted during the 2025 legislative session. The fixed rate is set by statute in Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ [66-489\(1\)](#) and [66-4,145](#).

The petroleum release remedial action fee is not included in the state motor fuels tax and remains unchanged at 0.9 cents per gallon on motor vehicle fuels and 0.3 cents per gallon on diesel fuels through September 30, 2026.

Effective October 1, 2026, the petroleum release remedial action fee will be 0.9 cents per gallon on motor vehicle fuels and 0.6 cents per gallon on undyed diesel fuels. Beginning October 1, 2026, dyed diesel is subject to a tax of 0.25 cents per gallon and is not subject to the petroleum release remedial action fee.
