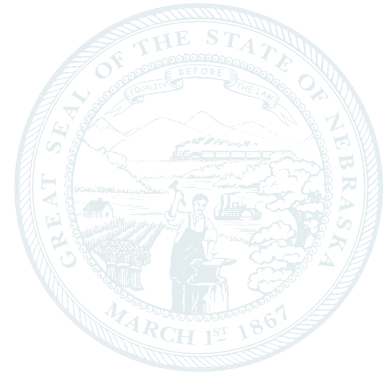

Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates – Effective July 1, 2021

No Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates for October 1, 2021

JUNE 7, 2021 (LINCOLN, NEB.) – Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced that the village of Manley will start a local sales and use tax rate of 0.5%, and the city of Humphrey will increase its existing rate from 1.5% to 2% effective on **July 1, 2021**.

For the calendar quarter starting on **October 1, 2021**, there are no local sales and use tax rate changes.
