Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates Effective for Quarters Beginning January 1, 2024 and April 1, 2024

DECEMBER 22, 2023 (LINCOLN, NEB.) — Nebraska Department of Revenue (DOR) Tax Commissioner James R. Kamm announced that beginning on January 1, 2024, the city of Kimball (9-273) will decrease its local sales and use tax rate from 1.5% to 1%.

For the quarter beginning on April 1, 2024, the city of Crofton (179-126) will increase its local sales and use tax rate from 1% to 1.5%.

These changes are on DOR's website at <u>revenue.nebraska.gov</u> under the Sales and Use Tax link. Retailers are reminded to regularly check the Sales Tax Rate Finder and the rate and boundary databases on DOR's website to ensure the correct tax rates.
