## Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates – Effective April 1, 2021

FEBRUARY 25, 2021 (LINCOLN, NEB.) – Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced the following changes that will be effective as of April 1, 2021.

- **Fordyce** will start a city sales and use tax rate of **1%**,
- **Spalding** will start a city sales and use tax rate of **1.5%**,
- **Gibbon, Guide Rock, and Hartington** will each increase its rate from 1% to **1.5%**, and
- **Upland** will increase its rate from 0.5% to **1.5%**.
