No Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates Effective July 1, 2022

Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rate Effective October 1, 2022

JUNE 6, 2022 (LINCOLN, NEB.) — Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced that there are no changes in local sales and use tax rates effective July 1, 2022.

However, beginning on the calendar quarter of October 1, 2022, the following changes will be effective for the villages and cities listed below:

- Bruning and Humboldt will start a local sales and use tax rate of 1.5%.
- Falls City, Gering, and West Point will each increase their local sales and use tax rate from 1.5% to 2%.
