Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates -Effective October 1, 2020

SEPTEMBER 10, 2020 (LINCOLN, NEB.) — Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced that effective October 1, 2020, the following changes will be effective in city sales and use tax rates:

- Ewing will start a 0.5% rate,
- · Rising City will start a 1% rate,
- · Davey, Dorchester, Milligan, Palmer, and Roca will each start a 1.5% rate,
- Bertrand, Superior, and Waverly will each increase its rate from 1.0% to 1.5%,
- Gretna will increase its rate from 1.5% to 2%, and
- Randolph will decrease its rate from 2.0% to 1.5%.
