## Changes in Local Sales and Use Tax Rates – Effective October 1, 2020

SEPTEMBER 10, 2020 (LINCOLN, NEB.) – Tax Commissioner Tony Fulton announced that effective October 1, 2020, the following changes will be effective in city sales and use tax rates:

- **Ewing** will start a **0.5%** rate,
- **Rising City** will start a **1%** rate,
- **Davey, Dorchester, Milligan, Palmer, and Roca** will each start a **1.5%** rate,
- **Bertrand, Superior, and Waverly** will each increase its rate from 1.0% to **1.5%**,
- **Gretna** will increase its rate from 1.5% to **2%**, and
- **Randolph** will decrease its rate from 2.0% to **1.5%**.
