Tax Year 2024 Homestead Exemption

The Nebraska Department of Revenue, Property Assessment Division (Department) reminds property owners that the [Nebraska Homestead Exemption Application, Form 458](#), must be filed with their county assessor between **February 2, 2024 and June 30, 2024**. For tax year 2024, June 30th is on a Sunday, which allows for applications to be timely filed on Monday, July 1st.

The homestead exemption provides relief from property taxes by exempting all or a portion of the taxable value of the residence. The State of Nebraska reimburses counties and other governmental subdivisions for the property taxes lost due to homestead exemptions.

In Nebraska, a homestead exemption is available to the following groups of persons:

- Persons over the age of 65;
- Qualified disabled individuals; or
- Qualified disabled veterans and their surviving spouses.

Some categories are subject to household income and residence valuation limitations. The income limitations are on a sliding scale.
