Emergency County Assessor/Deputy County Assessor Examination

December 4, 2025 (LINCOLN, NEB.) — Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-421(2), due to a vacant county assessor office, a county assessor certification examination (examination) will be held on **Thursday**December 18, 2025. The examination is held from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (CST) with a one-hour break for lunch. Examinations can be held in either Lincoln or North Platte as noted below.

Any interested applicants are to complete an application and submit it with payment to the Department of Revenue prior to taking the examination. Application forms and additional information can be obtained at revenue.nebraska.gov/PAD/assessor.

Certification and eligibility to hold office as a county assessor or deputy county assessor requires successful completion of this examination. Nebraska law prohibits an individual from filing for, or being appointed to, the office of county assessor or serving as deputy county assessor without a valid Nebraska Assessor Certificate. In addition, this certificate is required to be eligible to file for, or assume the office of, county clerk acting as an ex-officio county assessor
