Instructions

Who May File. [Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-3211](#) provides that law enforcement officers, judges, or members of the Nebraska National Guard participating in law enforcement may apply to the county assessor in their county of residence for their residential address to be withheld from the public by the county assessor, register of deeds, and county treasurer unless the residential address is requested in writing.

Definitions.

Law Enforcement Officer. Law enforcement officer means any member of the Nebraska State Patrol, any county or deputy sheriff, or any member of the police force of any city or village.

Law enforcement officer also means any member of the Nebraska National Guard participating in a law enforcement function as prescribed by the state, county, or local government.

Judge includes the judge or magistrate judge of any court located in this state, including any county court, district court, Nebraska Court of Appeals, the Nebraska Worker's Compensation Court, and separate juvenile court, the Nebraska Supreme Court, and any federal court.

Disclosure of Residential Address. A law enforcement officer, Nebraska National Guard Law Officer, or judge whose address is withheld from the public pursuant to this application may be released subject to the public records laws ([Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-712](#) et. seq.) when a written request is received by the county assessor, register of deeds, or county treasurer. *Such application does not guarantee that withheld residential addresses will not appear on scanned documents or other functions that are not immediately displayed in a search of records maintained by the county assessor, register of deeds, or county treasurer.*

Proof of Law Enforcement.

A law enforcement officer must complete the field for Law Enforcement ID Number on the application.

A member of the Nebraska National Guard acting as law enforcement, pursuant to [Neb. Rev. Stat. § 55-182](#), must provide a copy of a Military Occupation Specialty Job Class 31B, 31D, or 31E or a copy of current order from the military command.

Procedures. The county assessor shall notify the register of deeds and county treasurer regarding the receipt of a completed application. The county assessor, register of deeds, and county treasurer shall withhold the address of the applicant for five years after receipt of this application. The officer, member, or judge may renew his or her application every five years upon submission of an updated application to the county assessor.
