A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to provide for withholding the residential address of a law enforcement officer from the public; and to provide an operative date.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Unless requested in writing, the county assessor and register of deeds shall withhold from the public the residential address of a law enforcement officer who applies to the county assessor in the county of his or her residence. The application shall be in a form prescribed by the county assessor and shall include the name, address, and certified law enforcement identification number of the law enforcement officer and the parcel identification number for his or her residential address. The county assessor shall notify the register of deeds regarding the receipt of a complete application. The county assessor and the register of deeds shall withhold the address of a law enforcement officer who complies with this section for five years after receipt of a complete application. The law enforcement officer may renew his or her application every five years upon submission of an updated application.

Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2018.
