NOW this matter came on for hearing on the 27th day of May, 1983, upon defendants' Motion to dismiss for failure to prosecute. The Court now being duly advised in the premises FINDS, ORDERS, ADJUDGES AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) That the Petition in this case was filed by plaintiff on the 14th day of July, 1980.
- 2) That on the 18th day of July, 1980, defendants filed their Answer.
- 3) That on the 22nd day of ~~January~~ ^{December}, 1982, this Court ordered that cause be shown on or before the 25th day of January, 1983, why this case should not be dismissed for want of prosecution.
- 4) That on the 25th day of January, 1983, plaintiff filed a Motion requesting that this case be removed from the dismissal docket.
- 5) That on the 26th day of January, 1983, hearing was had on said Motion and this Court entered its Order directing that the case be removed from the dismissal docket and further ordered that the case be set for trial within 90 days and upon failure to do so said case would stand dismissed at plaintiff's costs.

- 7) That this case should be and hereby is dismissed at plaintiff's costs
