Instructions

Who Must File. The owner, lessee, or manager of any aircraft hangar or land where any aircraft is parked or located, must annually file this report, listing all aircraft based at the location as of January 1. Aircraft means any device invented, used, or designed for navigation of or flight in the air. See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 3-101.

When and Where to File. This report must be filed each year on or before February 1 with the county assessor in the county in which each aircraft is located.

Penalty for Failure to File. Any person who fails to provide the required report will be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction will be punished by a fine of not more than \$50. See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-1250.02.

Specific Instructions for County Assessors. A copy of all aircraft information reports filed in the county must be forwarded electronically to the Department of Revenue, Property Assessment Division by March 1.
