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### Reference for Class of School Districts:

**Class 2 (grades K-12)** includes any school district embracing territory having a population of one thousand inhabitants or less that maintains both elementary and high school grades under the direction of a single school board.

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**Class 3 (grades K-12)** includes any school district embracing territory having a population of more than one thousand and less than one hundred thousand inhabitants that maintains both elementary and high school grades under the direction of a single board.

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**Class 4 (grades K-12)** includes any school district embracing territory having a population of one hundred thousand or more inhabitants with a city of the primary class (city population 100,001-299,999) within the territory of the district that maintains both elementary and high school grades under the direction of a single board.

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**Class 5 (grades K-12)** include any school district embracing territory having a city of the metropolitan class (city population 300,000 or more) within the territory of the district that maintains both elementary grades and high school grades under the direction of a single board.

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**UNIFIED SCHOOL.** A unified school system allows for two or more Class 2 or 3 school districts to combine their resources to provide a K-12 education. The unified system is an interlocal agreement between the participating K-12 school districts.

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**LEARNING COMMUNITY.** All of the school districts with headquarters in a county containing a city of the metropolitan class or in a county that shares a border with a city of the metropolitan class are required to be a member of a learning community. The first learning community became operational in January 2009, for school districts headquartered in Douglas County and Sarpy County.

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
