

## Report on Results of the Tax Amnesty Program for 2009

**February 1, 2010** 



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In 2004, the Nebraska Department of Revenue conducted a tax amnesty program. Taxpayers were given an opportunity to apply for tax amnesty and pay all unreported taxes that were due before April 1, 2004. As part of this program, the Department of Revenue Enforcement Fund and the Department of Revenue Enforcement Technology Fund were created. In the following years, they were funded by delinquent tax collections resulting from this program.

In accordance with the filing and reporting requirements outlined in Neb. Rev. Stat § 77-5601, the Nebraska Department of Revenue submits the Report on Results of the Tax Amnesty Program.

- 1. No proceeds from the Department of Revenue Enforcement Fund were used to fund new positions in the Department of Revenue in 2009.
- 2. Proceeds from the Department of Revenue Enforcement Technology Fund were used to purchase the following items in 2009:
  - Additional desktop and laptop computers allowing employees to work at different locations with more applications available to enforce tax laws;
  - Software upgrades for some of the present database technology;
  - Data from state and federal agencies to detect the fraudulent filing of individual income tax returns and identify tax returns with underreported income; and
  - Additional training for staff working with data matching software.
- 3. In 2009, \$4.66 million of delinquent tax revenue was collected, which is 46.9% under the collection of \$8.77 million in 2008.
